

NOTICE OF COMMITTEE STAGE AMENDMENTS

THE NATIONAL PENSIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2010

In accordance with the provisions of Standing Order 52(1) and (2), I the Honourable Minister of Education, Training and Employment, give notice to move the following amendments to the National Pensions (Amendment) Bill, 2010:

That the Bill be amended as follows -

(a) by deleting clause 1 and substituting the following -

“Short title and expiry

1. (1) This Law may be cited as the National Pensions (Amendment) Law, 2010.

(2) Section 4 shall cease to have effect -

(a) in relation to an employee who is a Caymanian, upon the expiration of a period of one year; and

(b) in relation to an employee who is not a Caymanian, upon the expiration of a period of two years.

(3) Upon the expiration of section 4 in relation to a Caymanian employee or a non-Caymanian employee, as the case may be, the respective law in force immediately prior to the coming into operation of that section shall, so far as it is amended by that section, again operate as though that section had not been passed and the said amendments had not been enacted.

(4) In this section -


“Caymanian” has the meaning assigned to it by the Immigration Law (2009 Revision); and

“employee” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the Labour Law (2007 Revision).”.

(b) by deleting clauses 2 and 3; and

(c) by re-numbering clauses 4 and 5 as clauses 2 and 3, respectively.
