THE MERCHANT SHIPPING (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2014

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Merchant Shipping Law (2011 Revision).

Clause 1 provides for the short title.

Clause 2 amends section 462 of the principal Law to the effect that registration fees for ships shall be payable to the Maritime Authority rather than to the Treasury.
