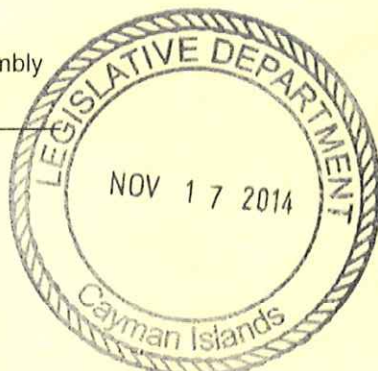

Answer

Her Excellency accepted the invitation to appoint a boundaries commission as requested in Government Motion No 1 2014/14 and as a result appointed the Electoral Boundary Commission on 23 December 2014 in accordance with section (88) (1) of The Cayman Islands Constitutional Order (2009).

The Commission is chaired by Dr. Lisa Handley. As per the section 88 (2)(b) of the constitution the Governor appointed Ms. Adriannie Webb, who was my nominee as Premier. Similarly the nominee of the Leader of Opposition as per section 88 (2)(c) was Mr. A. Steve McField was also appointed by Her Excellency the Governor.
