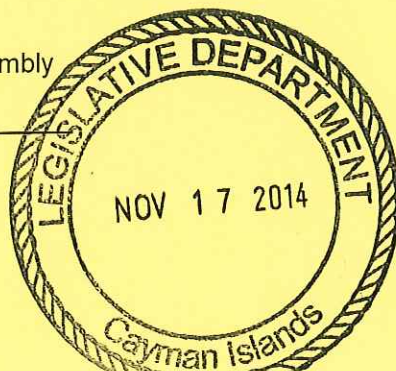

QUESTION:

Can the Honourable Minister say, what is the status of the Agreement between Navasota Energy and the Government?

ANSWER:

Madame Speaker, thank you for the opportunity to address this question. In order to answer this question, allow me to provide this honourable house an update of the Government's Agreement with Navasota Energy

Madame Speaker, the Agreement which the honourable member refers to is the proposed Fuel Terminal and Transfer Project. The proposed project would involve the construction and operation of a fuel loading and unloading facility (Transfer Terminal) and a new storage facility for product to be consumed locally.
