PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 5 OF 2015/2016

Motion on Pleasure Boating

WHEREAS there has been an increase of pleasure boats both in size and speed operating in Cayman waters

AND WHEREAS many of these new boat owners have no experience or knowledge of the rules and safety on the water while operating these large high powered pleasure boats.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT Government consider introducing regulations under the Port Authority Law, for enforcement by the Marine Police Unit, that anyone owning or operating a pleasure boat bigger than 21 feet and powered by engines larger than 150 horsepower be required to undergo training and pass a required test with the Port Authority concerning safety, rules of navigating and operating a boat in Cayman waters.
