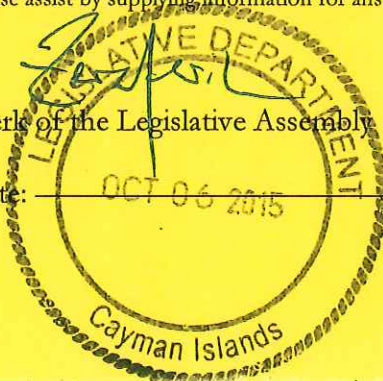

**QUESTION:** Can the Honourable Minister say what is being done by Government to assist the doctors currently employed by the Health Services Authority to obtain their board certification in their chosen medical specialty?

**ANSWER:** Madam Speaker, the Ministry of Education through the Education Council Scholarship programme has provisions in the current 2015/16 budget year to accommodate medical specialization opportunities for Caymanian doctors. In order to qualify, the Caymanian doctors must meet the academic criteria already established. This opportunity is not limited to Health Services Authority Employees.
