PARLIAMENTARY QUESTION ASKED BY ELECTED MEMBER FOR THE ELECTORIAL DISTRICT OF NORTH SIDE TO

THE HONOURABLE MINISTER FOR PLANNING, LANDS AGRICULTURE, HOUSING AND INFRASTRUCTURE

QUESTION: Can the Honourable Minister say, under what license does the two fuel companies (Rubis and Sol) own operating service stations to retail fuel, and how many such licenses does each fuel company own?

ANSWER: Madame Speaker, thank you for the opportunity to address this question from the Elected Member of the District of North Side.

Madame Speaker, there are no such licenses which provides for Rubis and Sol to own and operate service stations. Actually there are no restrictions preventing any legal citizen (local person or entity) from owning service stations. Furthermore to the question raised by the member, the LCCL does not restrict the fuel companies from owning property beyond their terminal.
