**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill seeks to amend the Cadet Corps Law, 2003, Law 32 of 2003, to change the Ministerial responsibility for the Cayman Islands Cadet Corps from the Minister charged with responsibility for education to the Minister charged with responsibility for the Cayman Islands Cadet Corps.
