PRIVATE MEMBER'S MOTION NO. 13/2017-2018

Newlands Public Transport Routes

WHEREAS the constituency of Newlands is not currently serviced by public transportation;

AND WHEREAS public transportation users either leaving or traveling to the constituency of Newlands must often walk long distances in excess of two miles to reach their destination or to get on a public bus;

AND WHEREAS many households and related individuals in the constituency of Newlands are impacted by the lack of direct public bus service in and out of their communities;

AND WHEREAS public transport users who wish to disembark closer to their destination in the constituency of Newlands are expected to pay an additional fare to the bus operator;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED That the Government considers creating permanent public transportation routes which serve the most populous areas of the constituency of Newlands with schedules coinciding with the peak usage hours of individuals who want to travel to or from the constituency of Newlands.
