MOTION ON BAIL LAW (2015 REVISION)

**WITHDRAWN BY HON D EZZARD MILLER – 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL 2019**

WHEREAS the Bail Law (2015 Revision) provides certain conditions under which bail can be granted by a court or police officer.

AND WHEREAS the Bail Law (2015 Revision) also provides that a person accused or convicted of certain offences is not entitled to bail.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Government consider amending the Bail Law (2015 Revision) to provide that a person who is on bail for charges under the Misuse of Drugs Law, and who is subsequently charged with additional offences under the Misuse of Drugs Law (2014 Revision), will not be entitled to bail for those successive offences.
