## Concessions for Tourist related Businesses

WHEREAS the Government has reported the highest level of visitors to the Islands in recent years;

AND WHEREAS this unprecedented level of visitors is expected to bring more opportunities for Caymanians in Tourism related Businesses;

AND WHEREAS the concentration of tourists in Grand Cayman, revolves around George Town and West Bay and their surrounding environs;

AND WHEREAS there are many tourist attractions in the three Eastern Districts which are not visited and enjoyed by tourists coming to the country;

AND WHEREAS there is unlimited potential for entrepreneurialism in the Eastern Districts in tourist related businesses;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED THAT the Government considers waiving all Government development fees, trade and business licensing fees, import duties, tourism related fees for residents proposing such developments in the Eastern Districts of Bodden Town, North Side and East End, with a construction value of under 300,000 dollars, and further, waive all fees on tourist related businesses in the Eastern Districts which do not have gross revenues in excess of 300,000 dollars per year.
