Motion to Make All Cayman Islands Laws Available Online for Free

WHEREAS Section 59 (2) of the Cayman Islands Constitution Order 2009 gives this Legislature the power to make laws for the peace, order, and good government of the Cayman Islands;

AND WHEREAS the ability to govern the people of the Cayman Islands can only come from the consent of the people of the Cayman Islands;

AND WHEREAS the Cayman Islands is a Constitutional Democracy governed by a Constitution and the rule of Law;

AND WHEREAS it is only fair that if the people of the Cayman Islands are to be governed by laws that those laws are easily accessible and available to them regardless of their geographic location and ability to pay;
