BILL, 2008**

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

It is necessary to enact in respect of each financial year an Appropriation Law giving the Governor in Cabinet authority to incur executive expenses, acquire executive assets, make equity investments or loans and undertake borrowing necessary for all services of the Government in that year in the manner directed by the Legislature.

This Bill is for Supplementary Appropriations for the financial year ending 30 June 2008 and seeks approval for changes to expenditure under the several heads of expenditure set out in the Schedule, and charges the expenditure on the revenue and funds of the Islands.
