THE EDUCATION (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2010

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Education Law (1999 Revision). The amendments are consequential upon the creation of the constitutional office of Minister charged with responsibility for finance.

Clause 1 of the Bill provides the short title.

Clause 2 amends paragraph 4 of the Third Schedule to the principal Law to empower the Minister responsible for finance to abate school fees, instead of the Financial Secretary.
