**THE NATIONAL ARCHIVE AND PUBLIC RECORDS (AMENDMENT)  
BILL, 2010**

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

This Bill amends the National Archive and Public Records Law, 2007. The amendments are consequential upon the creation of the constitutional office of Minister charged with responsibility for finance.

Clause 1 of the Bill provides the short title.

Clause 2 amends section 5 of the principal Law to enable a nominee of the Minister of Finance to be a member of the Records Advisory Committee, instead of the Financial Secretary.

1. This Law may be cited as the National Archive and Public Records (Amendment) Law, 2010. Short title

2. The National Archive and Public Records Law, 2007 is amended in section 5(1) by repealing paragraph (d) and substituting the following paragraph - Amendment of section 5  
of the National Archive  
and Public Records Law,  
2007 - the Records  
Advisory Committee  
“(d) a nominee of the member of the Cabinet charged with responsibility for finance;”.
