**THE LEGAL PRACTITIONERS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2009**

**MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS**

The object of this Bill is to increase the fees payable by attorneys-at-law admitted to practise law in the Cayman Islands from three hundred dollars to two thousand dollars.
