THE PRISONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2010

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill amends the Prisons Law (Law 14 of 1975) to create the offence of smuggling.

ENACTED by the Legislature of the Cayman Islands.

1. This Law may be cited as the Prisons (Amendment) Law, 2010.

Short title

2. The Prisons Law (Law 14 of 1975) is amended by inserting after section 43A the following section -

Insertion of new section 43B in the Prisons Law (Law 14 of 1975) - smuggling

"Smuggling

43B. Any person who -

- (a) brings, throws or in any manner introduces or conveys into any prison;
- (b) conveys to any prisoner while in custody outside of a prison;
- (c) with the intent that it shall come into the possession of a prisoner, deposits in any place outside of a prison; or
- (d) carries out of any prison,

an article or thing, unless he is authorized to do so by or under this Law or by the Director, commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of fifteen thousand dollars and to imprisonment not exceeding three years, or to

both such fine and imprisonment.”.
